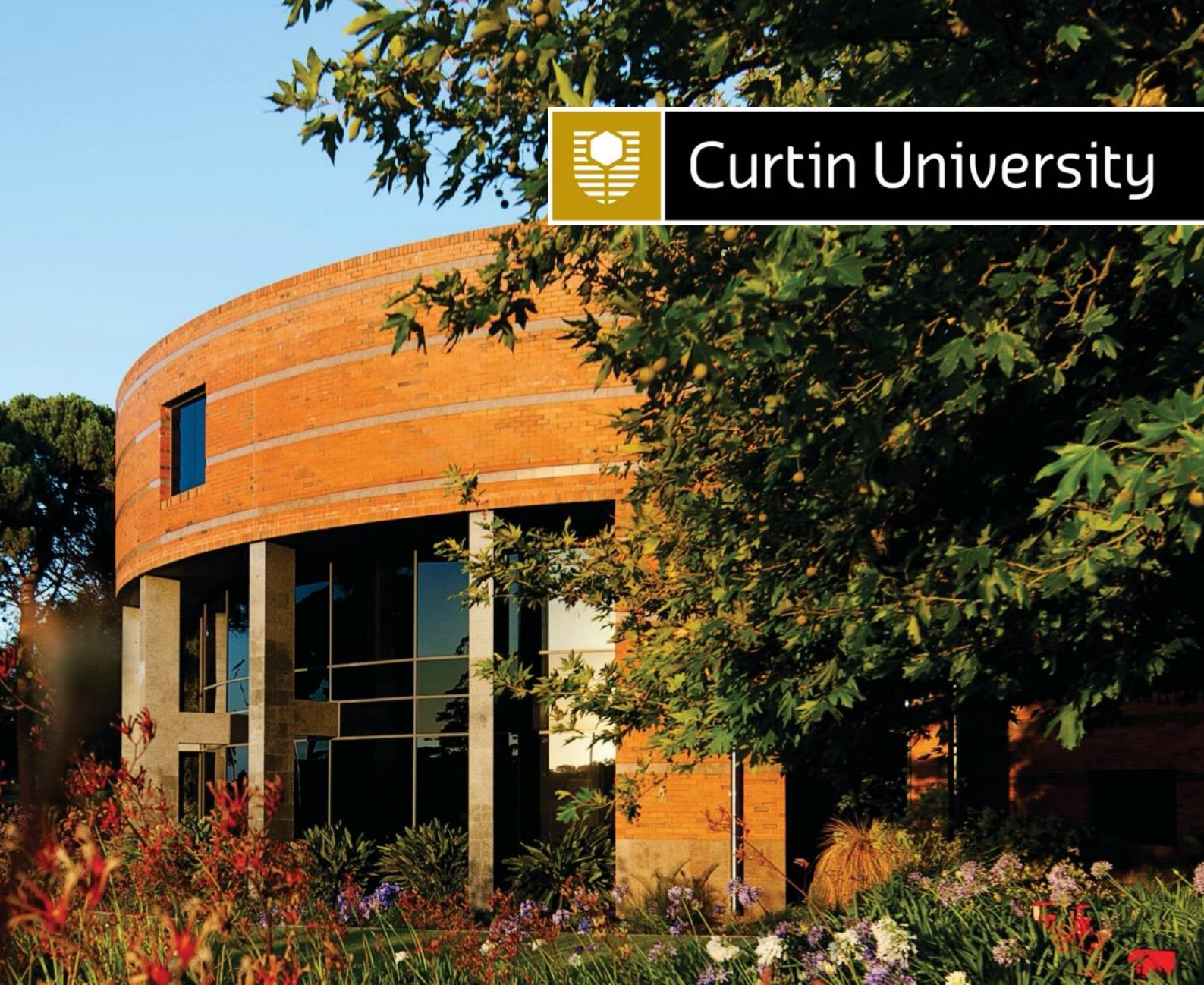

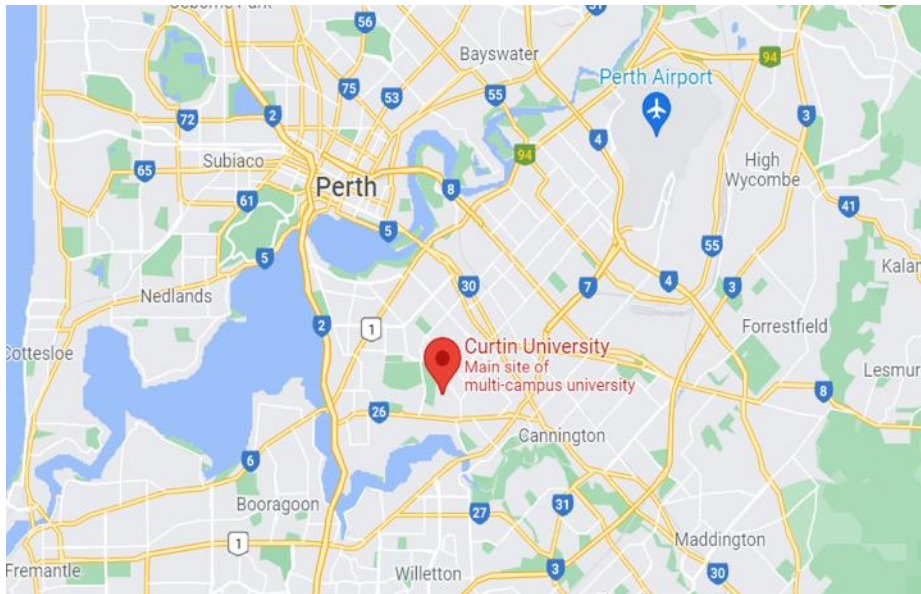

Getting to the gallery

The John Curtin Gallery (Building 200A) is part of Curtin University's Bentley Campus.

(The closest entrance is the Kent Street Main Entrance)

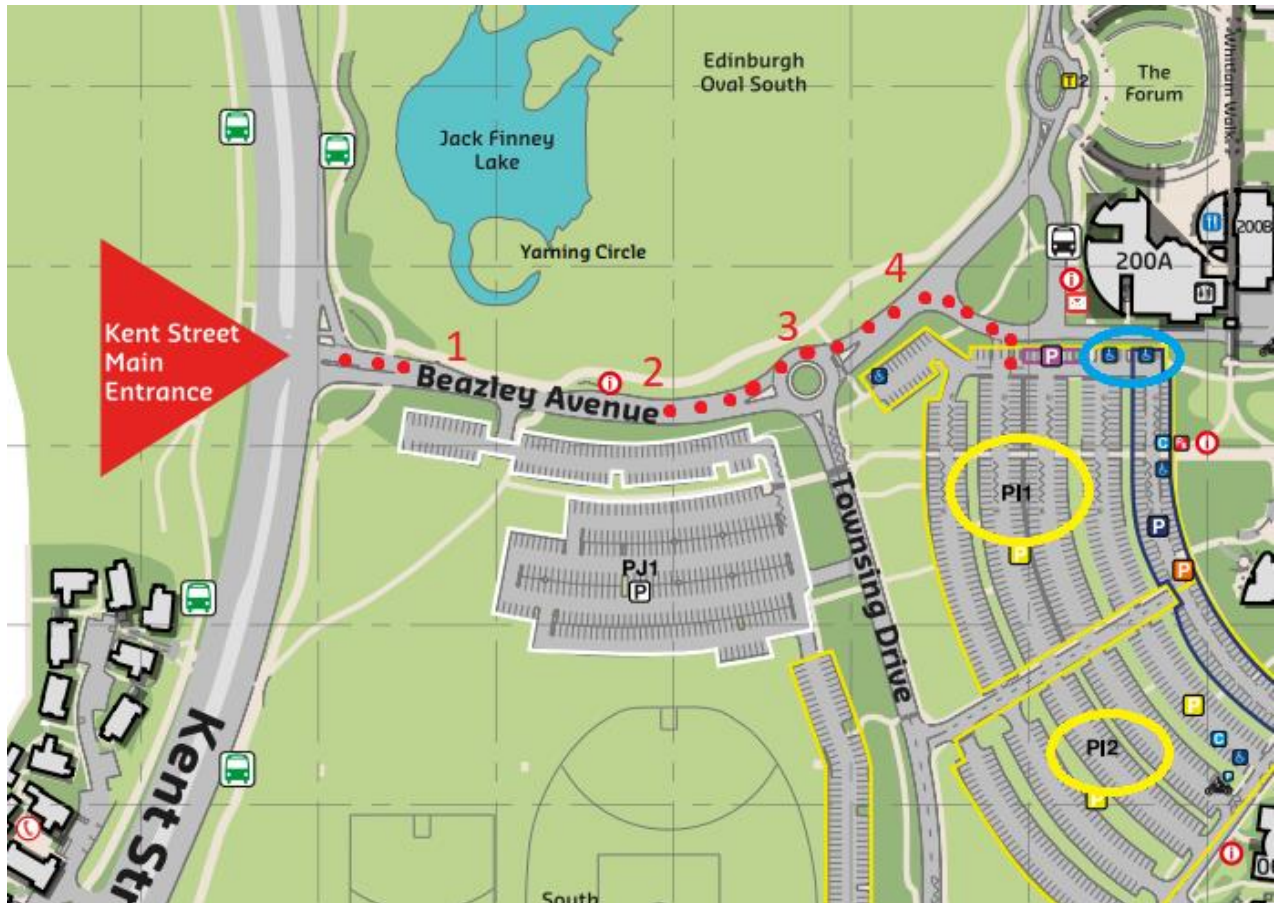


You may find the 'Lost on Campus' app helpful for getting around the Curtin Campus.

You can get the app on the app store or google play.

Parking

The closest place to the gallery to park is the yellow zones PI1 and PI2 off Beazley Avenue. There are ACROD parking places close to the Gallery (in the blue circle).



At Curtin, you need to use an app called CellOPark to pay for parking. To use CelloPark, you need to register. Once you're registered, you can start parking straight away. On weekdays parking in the yellow zones cost \$1.55 per hour, up to a maximum of \$6.30 per day.

ACROD parking is always free.

Photo Tour: Parking

This photo tour should assist you with finding your way to the gallery by car.



1

Continue down Beazley Ave.

After turning off Kent St, continue down Beazley Ave past this parking sign.



2

Continue towards the roundabout

Continue on Beazley Ave towards the roundabout.



3

Continue straight through the roundabout

When you get to the roundabout, go straight. After the roundabout you will be turning right (shown by the arrow).



4

Turn right

Continue down this road to the PI1 carpark and park your car.



Orange Parking

Orange parking is free for one hour. But you will still need to use CelloPark if you park here.



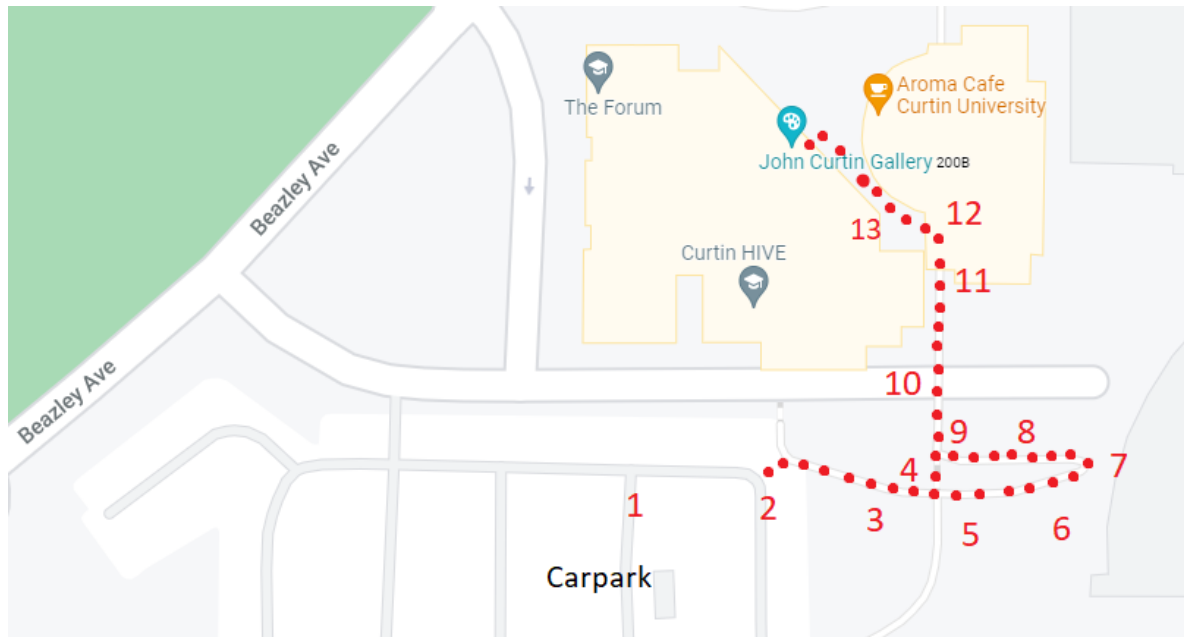
Blue Parking

Blue visitor parking is also available. It costs \$3.50 per hour to park here.

Most of the parking in PI1 is Yellow parking which \$1.55 per hour with a cap of \$6.30 per day.

This photo guide should help you get from the carpark to the Gallery



1

Head towards the John Curtin Gallery Building

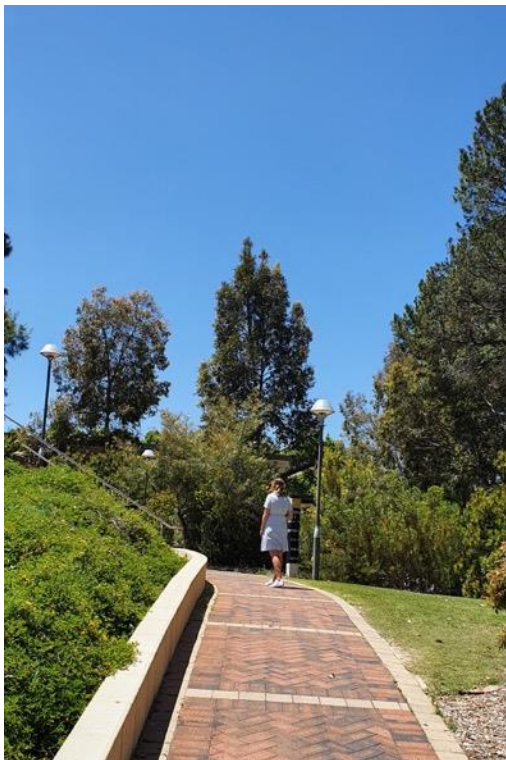
From the carpark, walk to the north-east corner with the building with the triangle window.



2

Turn right

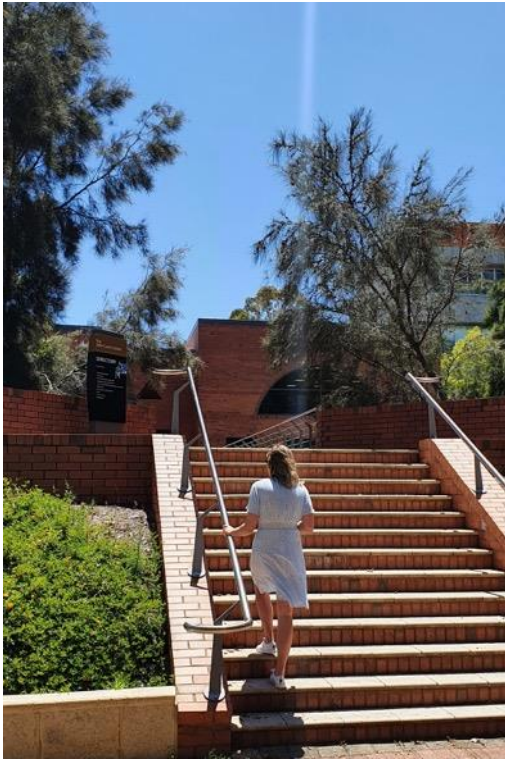
At the north-east corner of the carpark, turn right and walk east.



3

Continue up the path

Continue up the path until you reach the stairs on the left.



4

Walk up the stairs

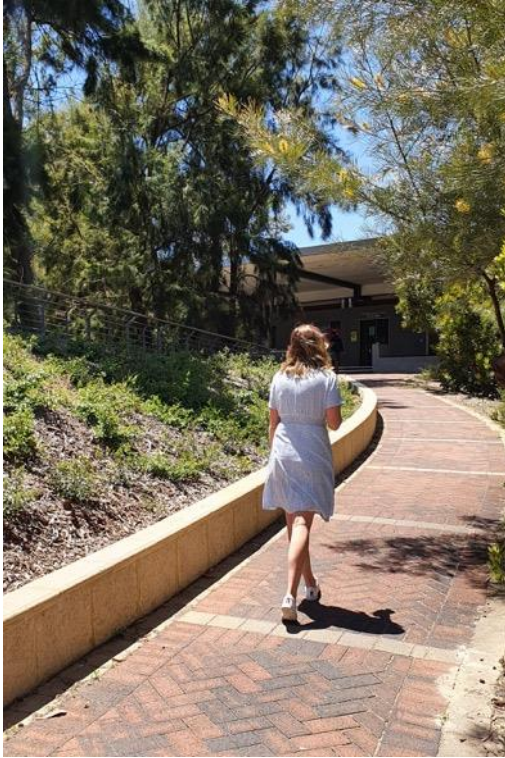
If you don't want to or can't use the stairs, skip this step (go to point 4)



5

Continue past the stairs

Continue up the ramp past the stairs



6
Continue up the ramp



7
Turn at the top of the ramp
At the top of the ramp, turn left and
continue back towards the top of the stairs.



8

Continue up the ramp

Keep going until you reach the top of the stairs.



9

Turn right at the directory sign

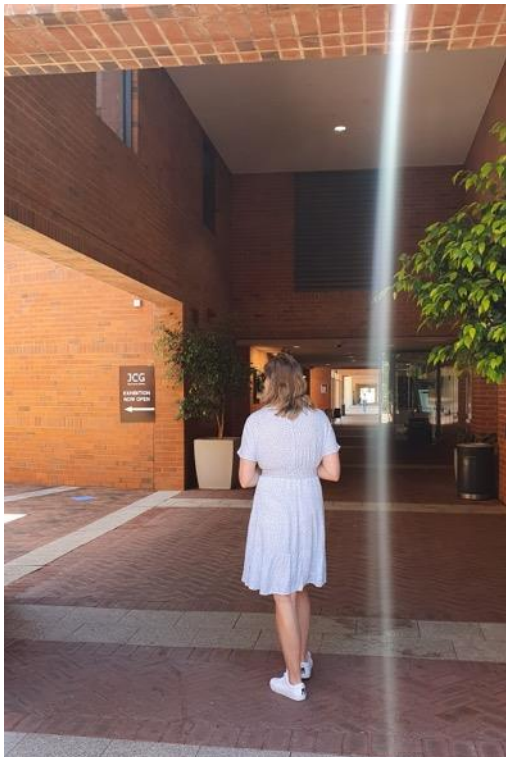
If you have come up the stairs, continue straight past the directory sign.



10

Walk across the bridge

Walk straight towards the triangle window



11

Walk into the breezeway



12

Turn left at the JCG sign

Turn left out of the breezeway, following the 'exhibition now open' sign.



13

Continue until you reach the entrance

Walk between the buildings. The entrance will be on your left.

Getting to the gallery by car



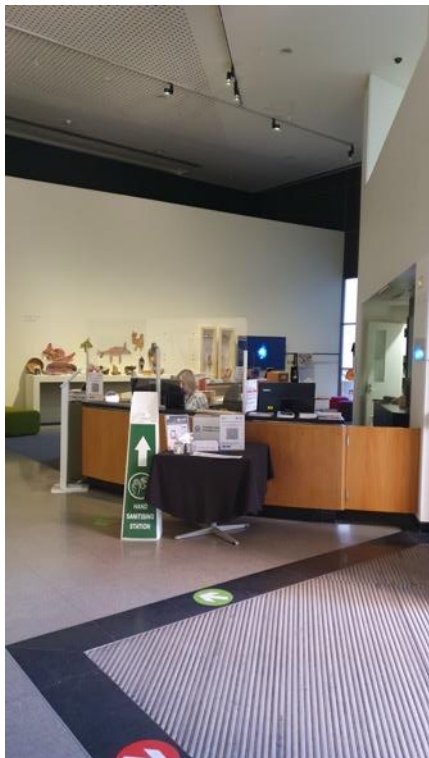
Sign in with the SafeWA app

If you don't want to use the app, there will be a paper and pen to sign in inside.



The Atrium

The atrium is the Gallery foyer. You can enter and of the gallery spaces from here.



Reception Desk
