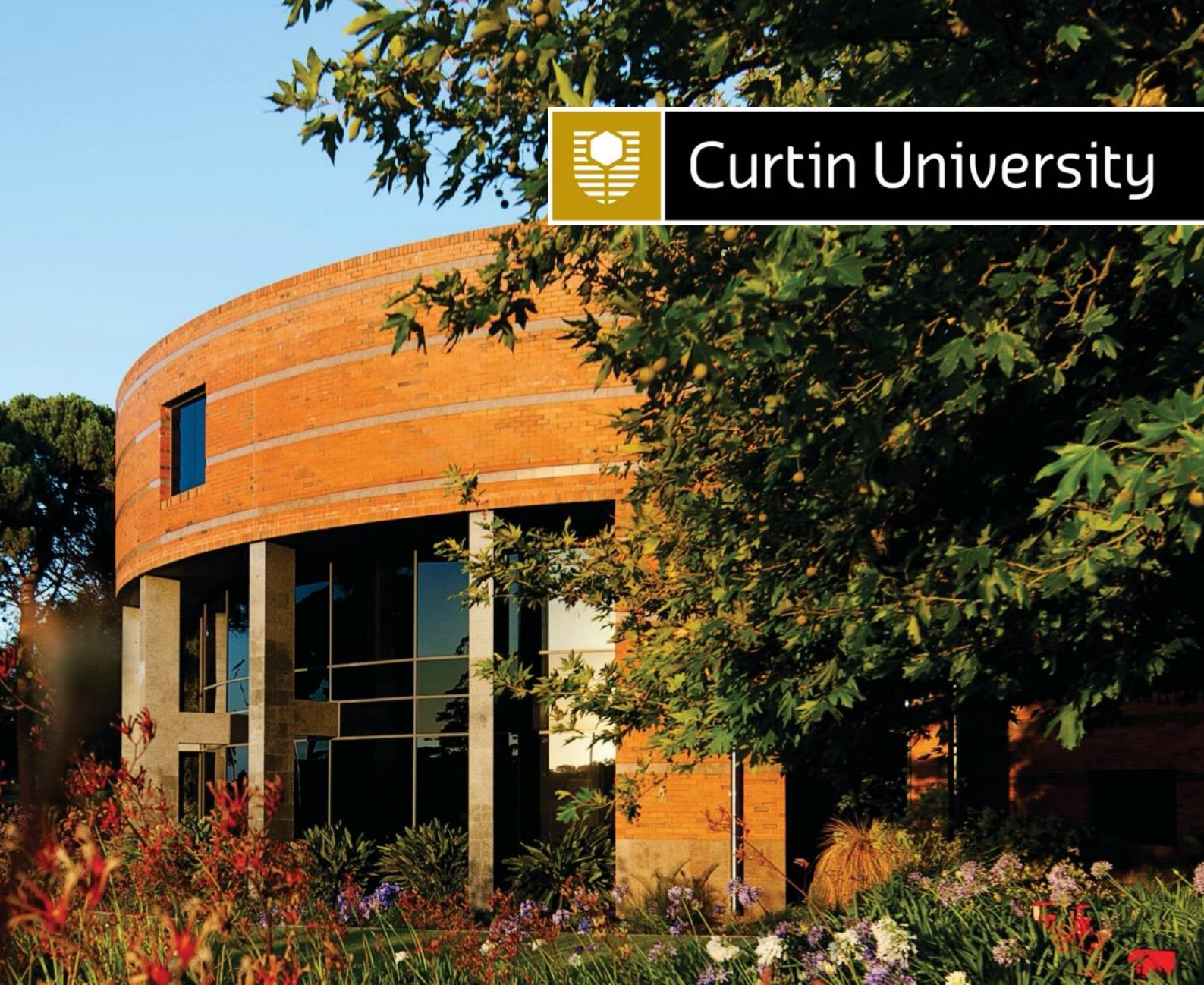

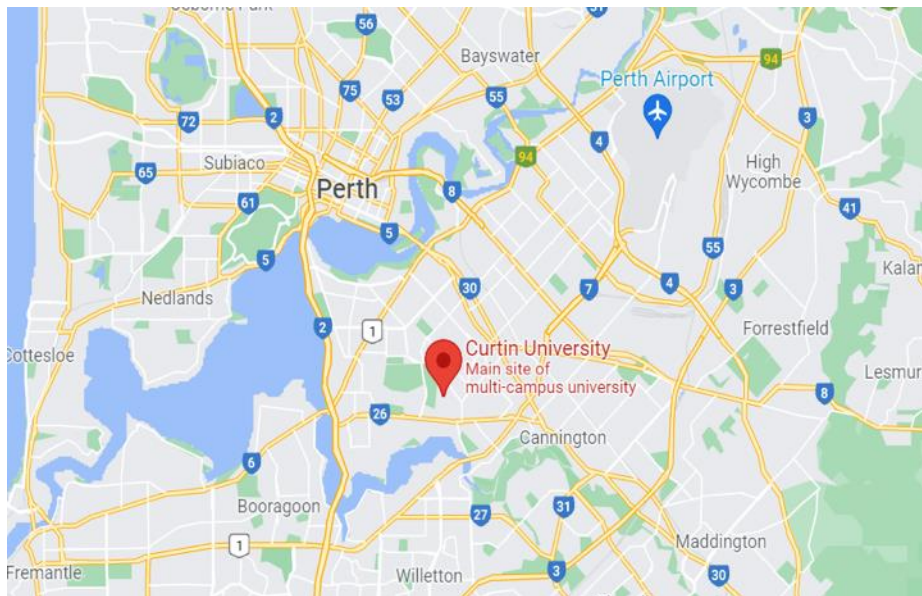

The John Curtin Gallery (Building 200A) is part of Curtin University's Bentley Campus.

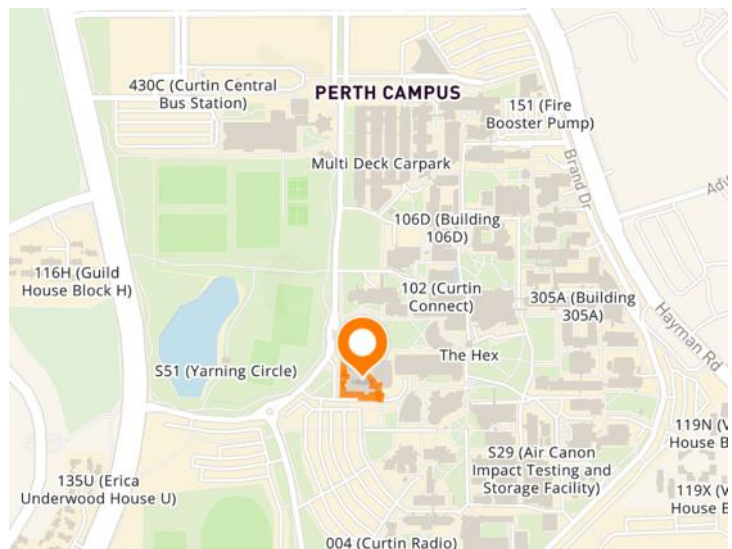

**You can get the app on the app store or google play.**

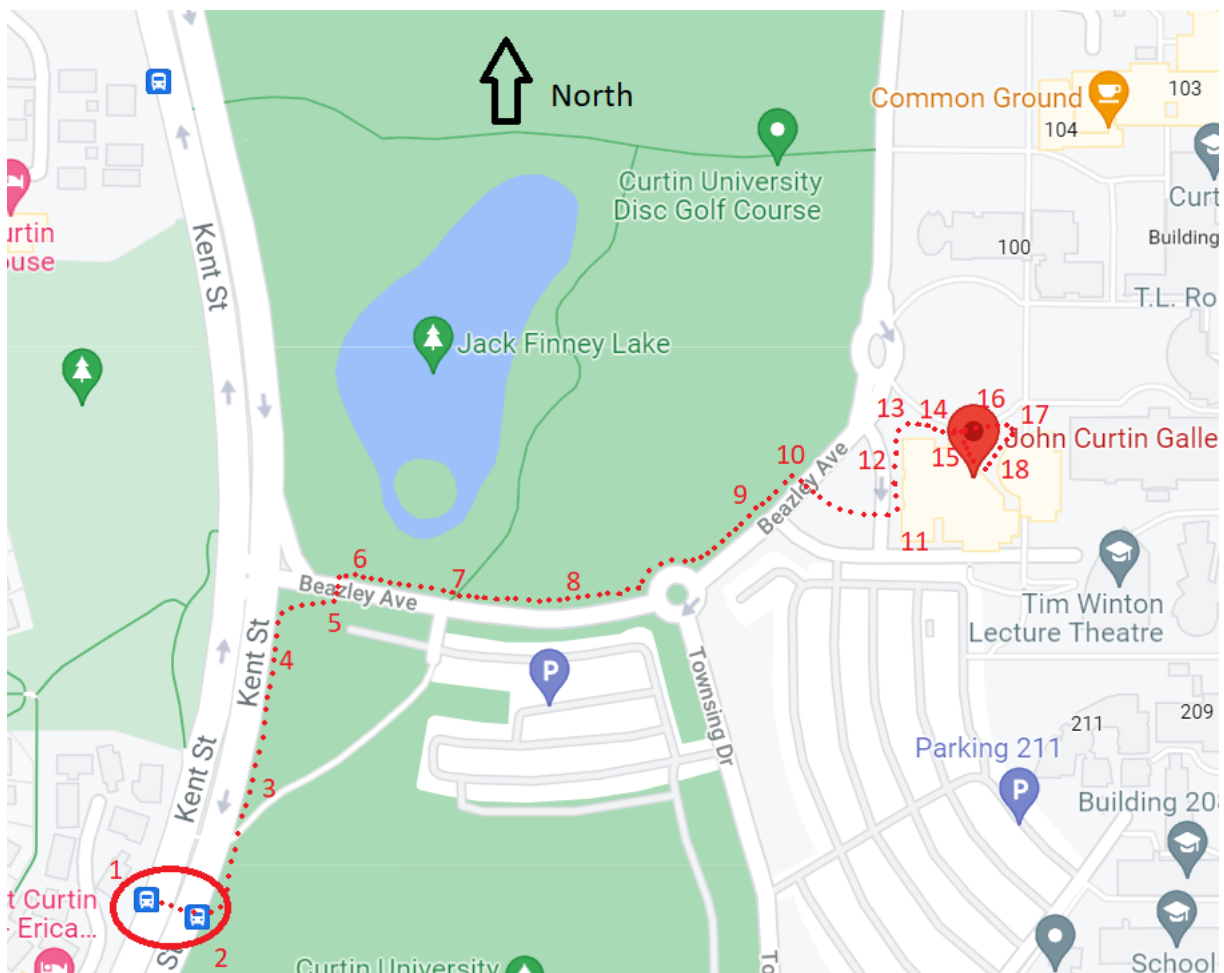
# Public Transport

If you are taking public transport to the gallery, you can plan your trip here:

There are two bus stops close to the Kent St entrance of Curtin University:

1. Kent St before Beasley Av (Stop ID 23924)
2. Kent St after Beasley Av (Stop ID 23927)



You can also take public transport to the Curtin Bus Stop, but it is on the other side of campus to the Gallery.

# Photo Tour

This photo tour should assist you with finding your way to the gallery. We go over bus stop 1 first, if you're coming from bus stop 2 turn the page.



**1**

## **Bus Stop 1**

Kent St before Beasley Av (Stop ID 23924)

Get off here if you're heading North



## **Cross the road**

Cross the road to the other side. For hygiene, use your elbow to press the button.



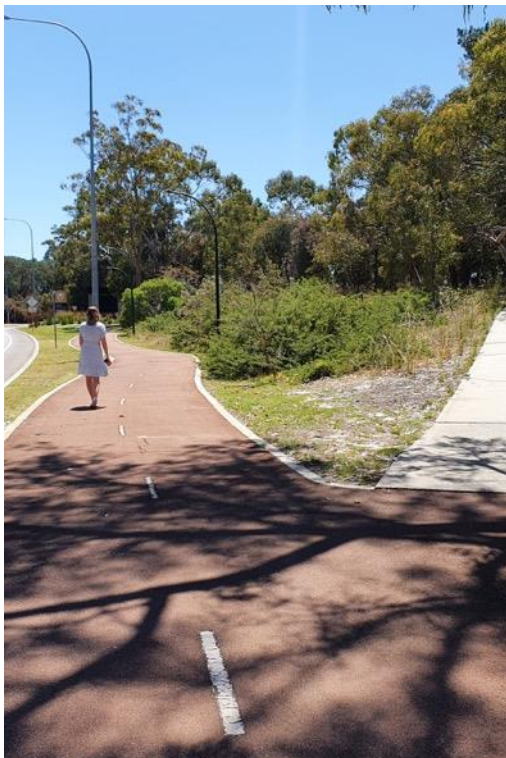


**2**

**Bus Stop 2**

Kent St after Beasley Av (Stop ID 23927)

Get off here if you're heading south.



**3**

**North Down the path**

Whether you've gotten off at bus stop 1 and cross the road or bus stop 2, head north down the red path.



## 4

### **Head towards the Kent St Entrance sign**

Keep walking north along the red path until you get to the Kent St Entrance (marked by large Curtin University signs)



## 5

### **Cross Beazley Ave**

Walk past the entrance signs, turn right, and cross Beazley Ave so you are walking on the North side of the road.





**6**

**Continue East**

Walk east along the path next to Beazley Ave away from Kent St.



**7**

**Continue along Beazley Ave.**

Keep walking along the path.





**8**

**Continue along Beazley Ave.**

Keep walking along the path past the roundabout.



**9**

**Turn at the crosswalk**

Keep walking along the path until you reach the crosswalk.



## **10**

### **Cross the crosswalk**

Cross the crosswalk, make sure to check for cars.



## **11**

### **Turn left**

After crossing the crosswalk, turn left and walk along next to the John Curtin Prime Ministerial Library building.



## 12

### **Walk past the directory sign**

Walk past the sign, don't turn right before the building.

The John Curtin Gallery is building 3 on this map. You will be walking between it and the grass area labelled 2.



## 13

### **Turn right to walk up the ramp**

After the sign, turn right and walk up the ramp between the grassed area and the building.





**14**

**Continue up the ramp**

Keep walking up the ramp. Feel free to use the rail if you need to.



**15**

**Walk up the steps on your right**

If you don't want to or can't use the steps, skip this step. These stairs end at the entrance to the gallery.



## **16**

### **Walk up the ramp**

Instead of using the steps, you can walk up the ramp between the grassed area and the café tables.



## **17**

### **Turn right at the top of the ramp**

Once you reach the top of the ramp, turn right.



## 18

### **Walk towards the gallery**

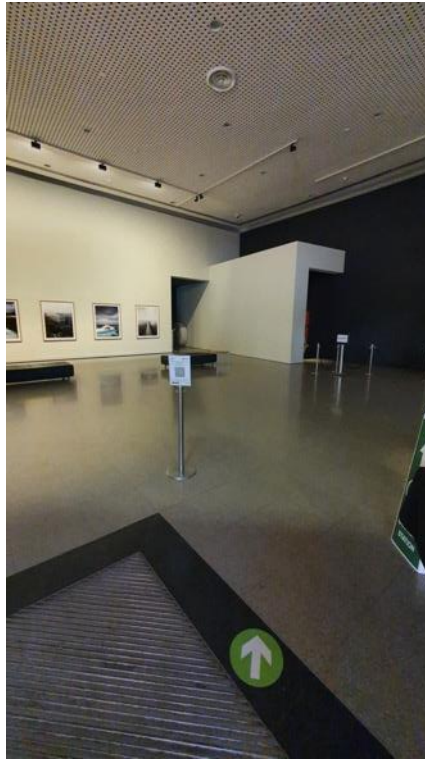
Walk past the café towards the gallery entrance.



### **Sign in with the SafeWA app**

If you don't want to use the app, there will be a paper and pen to sign in inside.





### **The Atrium**

The atrium is the Gallery foyer. You can enter and of the gallery spaces from here.



### **Reception Desk**

There will be a gallery staff member who can help you with information about current exhibitions and gallery facilities.
